

ROXY SCARF TUTORIAL

PATTERN BY LENALIS FOR ROSEVIEW, CHECKED BY WEBPIXIES

TUMBLR



Yarn weight: Worsted (I used *Lily Sugar 'n Cream* cotton yarn)

Gauge: Not vital, but (8 st = 2" across; 10 st = 2" high) in stockinette for this pattern. Your tension may have a minor impact on the proportions of Mutini.

Needles: US Size 7, 4.5mm (use a larger needle to cast on if you knit tightly)

Pattern notes: This pattern has seed stitch ends and sides to minimize curling, and the first stitch of each row is slipped to keep the edge even (selvedge). The most complicated part about following this pattern is being able to knit and purl in the same row, and making sure you do not twist your stitches.

Abbreviations:

CO – cast on

K – knit

P – purl

S1 wyf – slip 1 stitch with yarn to the front

S1 wyb – slip 1 stitch with yarn to the back

(instructions)* - repeat what is within the ()

rs – right side (the 'nice' side of stockinette)

ws – wrong side

BO – bind off

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Row 1 – CO 34 (I used Continental with a 30" tail)
 Row 2 – S1 wyf, P1, K1, (P1, K1)* to last stitch, P1
 Row 3 – S1 wyb, K1, P1, (K1, P1)* to last stitch, K1
 Row 4 – (repeat Row 2)
 Row 5 – (repeat Row 3)
 Row 6 (rs) – S1 wyf, P1, K1, K to last three stitches, P1, K1, P1
 Row 7 (ws) – S1 wyb, K1, P1, P to last three stitches, K1, P1, K1
 Rows 8, 10, 12, 14 – (repeat Row 6)
 Rows 9, 11, 13, 15 – (repeat Row 7)

Rows 16-41 are the Mutini pattern themselves, and I have bracketed off the seed stitch border so it does not complicate the pattern stitch count. All rows total 34 stitches on your needle, 28 of which are dedicated to Mutini. I have included a chart with the rows written out.

Row 16 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K12, P4, K12 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 17 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P10, K8, P10 [K1, P1, K1]
 Row 18 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K9, P10, K9 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 19 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P8, K12, P8 [K1, P1, K1]
 Row 20 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K7, P14, K7 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 21 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P6, K5, P2, K2, P2, K5, P6 [K1, P1, K1]
 Row 22 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K5, P5, K1, P2, K2, P2, K1, P5, K5 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 23 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P5, K5, P1, K6, P1, K5, P5 [K1, P1, K1]
 Row 24 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K4, P20, K4 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 25 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P4, K20, P4 [K1, P1, K1]
 Row 26 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K3, P5, K2, P8, K2, P5, K3 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 27 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P3, K4, P4, K6, P4, K4, P3 [K1, P1, K1]
 Row 28 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K3, P4, K4, P6, K4, P4, K3 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 29 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P2, K6, P2, K8, P2, K6, P2 [K1, P1, K1]
 Row 30 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K2, P24, K2 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 31 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P5, K18, P5 [K1, P1, K1]
 Row 32 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K5, P6, K2, P2, K2, P6, K5 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 33 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P5, K6, P1, K4, P1, K6, P5 [K1, P1, K1]
 Row 34 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K5, P18, K5 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 35 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P5, K18, P5 [K1, P1, K1]
 Row 36 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K6, P16, K6 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 37 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P6, K5, P6, K5, P6 [K1, P1, K1]
 Row 38 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K6, P4, K8, P4, K6 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 39 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P7, K3, P8, K3, P7 [K1, P1, K1]
 Row 40 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K7, P2, K10, P2, K7 [P1, K1, P1]
 Row 41 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P8, K1, P10, K1, P8 [K1, P1, K1]

Mutini is complete.

Row 42, 44, 46, 48, 50, 52 – (repeat Row 6)
 Row 43, 45, 47, 49, 51, 53 – (repeat Row 7)

End patterned stripe.

From here, each stripe is continued in stockinette stitch with its seed stitch borders. For my scarf, I made 10 plain stripes, and each stripe 50 total rows.

Switch colors

Row 1 and odd rows – S1 wyf, P1, K1, K to last three stitches, P1, K1, P1

Row 2 and even rows – S1 wyb, K1, P1, P to last three stitches, K1, P1, K1

When it comes to the last stripe, you are free to end in either of your colors. You can have two Mutinis of the same color, or one of each. I will continue the pattern with Row 1 being the start of my final stripe, and from there Mutini will be knit in reverse row order (see chart).

Row 1 – S1 wyf, P1, K1, K to last three stitches, P1, K1, P1

Row 2 – S1 wyb, K1, P1, P to last three stitches, K1, P1, K1

Rows 3, 5, 7, 9, 11 – (repeat Row 1)

Rows 4, 6, 8, 10, 12 – (repeat Row 2)

Row 13 – (repeat Row 1) – ends with ‘wrong side’ stockinette (excluding border)

Begin Mutini:

Row 14 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P8, K1, P10, K1, P8 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 15 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K7, P2, K10, P2, K7 [P1, K1, P1]

Row 16 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P7, K3, P8, K3, P7 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 17 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K6, P4, K8, P4, K6 [P1, K1, P1]

Row 18 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P6, K5, P6, K5, P6 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 19 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K6, P16, K6 [P1, K1, P1]

Row 20 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P5, K18, P5 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 21 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K5, P18, K5 [P1, K1, P1]

Row 22 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P5, K6, P1, K4, P1, K6, P5 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 23 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K5, P6, K2, P2, K2, P6, K5 [P1, K1, P1]

Row 24 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P5, K18, P5 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 25 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K2, P24, K2 [P1, K1, P1]

Row 26 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P2, K6, P2, K8, P2, K6, P2 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 27 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K3, P4, K4, P6, K4, P4, K3 [P1, K1, P1]

Row 28 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P3, K4, P4, K6, P4, K4, P3 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 29 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K3, P5, K2, P8, K2, P5, K3 [P1, K1, P1]

Row 30 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P4, K20, P4 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 31 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K4, P20, K4 [P1, K1, P1]

Row 32 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P5, K5, P1, K6, P1, K5, P5 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 33 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K5, P5, K1, P2, K2, P2, K1, P5, K5 [P1, K1, P1]

Row 34 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P6, K5, P2, K2, P2, K5, P6 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 35 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K7, P14, K7 [P1, K1, P1]

Row 36 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P8, K12, P8 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 37 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K9, P10, K9 [P1, K1, P1]

Row 38 – [S1 wyb, K1, P1] P10, K8, P10 [K1, P1, K1]

Row 39 – [S1 wyf, P1, K1] K12, P4, K12 [P1, K1, P1]

Mutini is complete.

Row 40 – S1 wyb, K1, P1, P to last three stitches, K1, P1, K1

Row 41 – S1 wyf, P1, K1, K to last three stitches, P1, K1, P1

Rows 42, 44, 46, 48 – (repeat Row 40)
Rows 43, 45, 47, 49 – (repeat Row 41)
Row 50, 52 – S1 wyb, K1, (P1, K1)*
Row 51, 53 – S1 wyf, P1, (K1, P1)*
